## WHO, WHAT AND WHY?

When teachers know the key elements of establishing a culture for learning, they know what their students need and how to establish classroom practices for student engagement and learning. Student engagement is not the same as student participation in the class.

Are your students truly engaged in challenging activities that require them to think, evaluate, justify and synthesize?

This course is designed to provide you with an overview of research-based protocols, visual organizers and high-level questioning strategies. Furthermore, it includes classroom examples, ideas for questioning, use of Costa/Bloom's Taxonomy and compare/contrast strategy that can be adapted for every grade level.

- What are the different multimedia tools and organizers that support student learning?
- How to involve students to create their learning environment and build a community?

Examine questions for dialogue and productive thinking among students and use Costa/Bloom's taxonomy to frame questions for different grade levels.

## **MODULE 3: MAKING LEARNING VISIBLE**

Build a repertoire of tools and techniques to make teaching and learning visible and support student learning.

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
